



In 2005, the Manitoba Government approved the Physician Profiles Regulation. The Profile is intended to assist the public in selecting physicians. The development of the Physician Profiles has been a lengthy process for both the College and Government representatives. The Government has been respectful of physicians' privacy in the development of the profile. The government was also accommodating in addressing concerns raised by Council. We have also received a commitment from the Minister of Health that all reasonable costs related to profiling will be supported by the Government.

At the time of registration or licensure, physicians are required to complete a Physician Profile Form to provide additional information that is not already available on the Medical Register. The law requires that all physicians provide this information to the College. **Furthermore, physicians are required to update profile information** by advising the College in writing of any change in the posted profile information within 30 days of the change.

Physician Profile Information - Required by Law

(A form will be provided for the physician to complete. The following is for information only)

- A. Member's current name as/will be shown in the Manitoba Medical Register.
- B. Member's Sex. Members are entitled to request in writing that information as to their sex not be included.
- C. Primary Practice Address.
- D. Name of Medical school and Year of Graduation.
- E. Type of Postgraduate Clinical Training, country where completed and year completed.
- F. Date of Registration on the Manitoba Medical Register.
- G. Current field of practice
- H. Final disciplinary action taken against the member in any jurisdiction and for any profession since January 2001.
For each decision reported the physician must indicate: (a) if the appeal period has NOT expired, the date on which it will expire and (b) whether an appeal is pending.
- I. Current restrictions, terms or conditions respecting the member's registration or licence, including any geographic or practice restrictions pending full registration.
- J. Commencement date of any current interim suspension from the practice of medicine in any jurisdiction.
- K. Current certification by The College of Family Physicians of Canada, The Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada or a body in a jurisdiction outside Canada which is responsible for certifying physicians as a specialist or for specialty practice.
- L. The date of any medical malpractice court judgment issued by a court in Canada within the past ten year period and the name of the court which issued it.
For each decision reported the physician must indicate: (a) if the appeal period has NOT expired, the date on which it will expire and (b) whether an appeal is pending.
- M. Description of any offence under The Criminal Code, The Controlled Drugs and Substances Act (Canada) or The Food and Drugs Act (Canada) of which the member has been convicted within the past ten year period, including the date of conviction and the name of the court.
For each decision reported, the physician must indicate: (a) if the appeal period has NOT expired, the date on which it will expire and (b) whether an appeal is pending.

Physician Profile Information - Voluntary Information Not Required by Law

- A. Office Telephone Number
- B. Wheelchair Accessibility to the Office
- C. Languages (other than English) spoken (including American Sign Language) and availability of interpretation
- D. Teaching Responsibilities
