

**REQUIREMENTS FOR REGULATED MEMBER,  
PROVISIONAL REGISTRATION - ACADEMIC – VISITING PROFESSOR  
[CPSM General Regulation, s. 3.12]**

The purpose of the provisional (academic – visiting professor) category is to provide registration for an eligible physician to:

1. Attend to teach or to learn for a term approved by the Registrar;
2. Have, during that time, clinical contact with patients and provide limited medical services in circumstances approved by the Registrar.

**CREDENTIALS:**

1. A degree from an nationally approved faculty of medicine or a Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine degree from a school in the United States accredited by the American Osteopathic Association Commission on Osteopathic College accreditation.

**REQUIREMENTS CONFIRMED BY DEAN OF THE MANITOBA FACULTY:**

1. A written request from the dean of the Manitoba Faculty (or the dean's designate) to grant approval for the registration, which:
  - a. confirms that the applicant meets the requirements for [English language fluency](#) set by council;
  - b. confirms that the applicant is or will be legally entitled to work or study in Manitoba before he or she begins to engage in professional practice;
  - c. describes the applicant's current and proposed professional practice or the specific procedures that the applicant will be performing;
  - d. the name of the person and the department that will be responsible for supervising the applicant's practice; and
  - e. the dates when and location(s) where the applicant will be teaching or studying.

**CONDITIONS:**

Conditions which may attach to a visiting professor registration will include:

1. If appropriate, restricting practice to the procedure or teaching experience for which the applicant is attending; a description of the specific medical procedure that the applicant will be performing.
2. Restriction on the location(s) of practice; the dates when and the location or locations where the applicant will be teaching or studying

Other conditions may be imposed, depending upon the circumstances.

**TIME LIMITED REGISTRATION**

Provisional (academic – visiting professor) registration is for a period of not more than 24 consecutive months, unless extended by the Registrar for up to 12 additional months. An extension may be granted only if:

1. The physician provides a written request from the dean of the Manitoba Faculty (or the dean's designate) for an extension before the initial registration expires and sets out the reasons for the extension request.
2. The Registrar determines that there are exceptional or extenuating circumstances that merit an extension. The Registrar must provide written reasons for his or her approval or refusal of the extension and, if the Registrar does not grant an extension, the physician has a right of appeal.
