

## CANCELLATION [Regulated Health Professions Act (RHPA), s. 48(1) to 52

A Registrar may cancel a member's registration or certificate of practice:

(a) If the council has directed the Registrar to cancel a member's registration when the member's registration or certificate of practice, or both, have been obtained by means of a false representation or declaration,

(b) If the council has directed the Registrar to cancel a member's registration when the member has been convicted of an offence that is relevant to his or her suitability to practice;

- (c) Upon receipt of proof that the member is deceased;
- (d) If the Registrar is satisfied that the registration certificate has been issued in error;
- (e) Upon the request of the member.
