BYLAW #5

(This Bylaw was enacted by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba on June 17, 2005
with Amendments to June 12, 2008)

COLLEGE OF PHYSICIANS AND SURGEONS OF MANITOBA

BY-LAW #5

PRESCRIBING PRACTICES

1. Physicians must prescribe the drugs listed in Schedule A only in the manner prescribed in this By-Law.
2. All prescription drugs in Schedule A shall be written on such prescription form as is approved by the College from time to time, and made available only through The Manitoba Pharmaceutical Association.
3. The prescription shall be valid for only 3 days after its issuance to the patient, and the physician must so advise the patient.
4. The prescription must be legible and shall include:
 - the date.
 - the patient name and address.
 - the number of repeats, where applicable.
 - the quantity and dose.
 - the physician registration number with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba.
 - for Clinical Assistants, the co-signature of a licensed medical practitioner, whether the prescription is for an inpatient or an outpatient.
5. This By-Law does not apply to:
 - (a) prescriptions for drugs administered in a personal care home as described under the Manitoba Health Services Insurance Act.
 - (b) prescriptions for drugs administered in a hospital.
 - (c) the direct administration of a designated drug to a patient by a physician.
6. The College may grant exemption from this By-Law where it deems that such exemption is appropriate.
