### Instructions to Applicants

Complete the application if applying for conditional registration and return to the College offices along with the non-refundable documentation fee (\$275) and supporting documentation.

Applicants for general practice must also submit a separate application to the Office of Continuing Medical Education, International Medical Graduates Assessment for Conditional Licensure (IMGACL). Applicants for general (family) practice are encouraged to contact the Physician Resource Coordination Office (PRCO) [PRCO, Manitoba Health Workforce Policy & Planning, Room 1043-300 Carlton Street, Winnipeg R3B 3M9 (204 788 6668)] to determine eligibility for a Minister's Certificate (item II(e) in the "Requirements for Conditional Registration").

**Item 3** must be completed ONLY if you are a graduate of a medical school in Canada or the United States. All others see **Item 8**.

**Item 4.** Evidence of good standing must be sent by the licensing authority(s) directly to the College offices. Please ensure that the licensing authority(s) is made aware of the information that must be included in the certificate. You may photocopy item 4 and send it with your request to the licensing authority(s).

**Item 5.** Candidates for general practice will be required to complete the assessment process in place at the time the candidate is referred for assessment.

Complete and return **Item 6** to the College offices if applying for the NRSAP (specialty area of practice).

**Item 7.** A CRC must be provided to the College. You may attend at a local RCMP detachment or your local law enforcement agency. **You must ensure that the Check contains a Vulnerable Sector Search (VSS).** Once the check has been completed, you must send the original to the College offices. You **must** complete and return the CRC Undertaking with your application. If a VSS cannot be obtained with the CRC from the local authority, you must obtain a VSS from the Winnipeg Police Services, Public Safety Building, at 151 Princess Street, Winnipeg, within 30 days of registration being granted.
