

PRACTISING WITHOUT A LICENCE

Where as a result of an oversight, a physician registered with and previously licensed by the College commences or resumes practise without proper licensure, the physician may apply in writing to the Executive for approval of an amendment making the licensure retroactive for a period equal to the lesser of:

- (a) The date practice commenced; or
- (b) A date approved by the Executive Committee prior to the date of the application to the Executive for an amendment.

The application shall contain a written explanation of the circumstances which resulted in the oversight. Issuing a licensure effective a date other than the date of renewal shall be in the sole discretion of the Executive.

Where the Executive Committee approves a request for retroactive licensure, the physician shall pay a penalty in the amount of \$50.00 per day for each day of the retroactive period.
