

## FURTHER RESOURCES REQUIRED AS IDENTIFIED THROUGH CONSULTATION

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- ***Technical Platform for physicians to be able to comply with Standard***
  - Access to DPIN for all physicians
  - Access to eChart for some physicians
  
- ***Access to Specific Practitioners required***
  - Addictions specialists for patient treatment
  - Opioids and Addiction hotline for physicians
  - Physiotherapists
  - Psychiatrists
  - Psychologists
  - Pain management specialists
  - Pediatric pain management specialists
  
- ***Specific Programs Identified requiring further resources***
  - Cognitive Behaviour Therapy programs
  - Pain management clinic - more resources, staff, other locations
  - Pain Management Clinic hotline for physicians
  - Opiate Assessment Clinic at HSC – more resources, staff, other locations
  - Addictions Unit at HSC – more resources, other locations
  - Addictions Foundation Manitoba
  - ER may experience more patients seeking opioids
  
- ***Northern Manitoba (Remote Populations)***
  - Access required for interdisciplinary resources
  - Access to non-pharmacological resources
  - Access to specialists in addiction, pain, psychology, psychiatry, sports medicine, etc.

- ***Financial Commitment required***
  - Funding for non-pharmacological treatment
  - Tariff increase for physicians performing a comprehensive assessment
  - More patient visits required for prescribing leads to increased billing frequency
  
- ***Supports for Patients with Decreased Opioids***
  - Variety of social issues arising
  - Policing Services involved in illegal opioids
  - Overall system-wide resources arising from deaths due to illegal opioids
  - Paramedics for overdoses due to use of illegal opioids
  - Abandoned patients – calls, system issues
  - Government can expect calls from patients with lesser access to opioids or abandoned
  
- ***Work with CPSM and other stakeholders on implementation***
  - Continued Information sharing
  - Supportive funding request
